*It's All About Competitive Trail Riding !*



Have you wondered what a NORTH AMERICAN TRAIL RIDE CONFERENCE (NATRC) Competitive trail ride is all about? Maybe you've tried one in the past and would like to learn more or to sharpen up your trail riding skills. Well, here is your chance to participate in a "hands on" experience. With our low "mentor to rider" ratio, this will be an unusual opportunity to get some great personalized coaching in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere!

Please join us for this fun and educational "Introduction to NATRC" clinic at the Greenland Open Space (conveniently located just off I-25 between Castle Rock and Colorado Springs). Bring your horse or you can even come without one as an auditor. We will divide the clinic participants into groups of 4 to 5 riders linked up with one experienced NATRC rider (We can assign parents/kids and friends to the same group). The groups will then go from "station to station" so everyone will have a chance to learn some tips and to observe execution of many of the obstacles you might find on a competitive trail ride. A short "practice" 4 mile trail ride with your mentor will be included. Those without a horse ("auditors") will have an experienced 'coach' as well, who will explain what the riders are doing. It is also a great way to meet like-minded new friends and contacts!

**These clinics fill up quickly - we will have a limited number of spaces, so try to register early!**

**Schedule:**

8:30 AM-----Arrive: park and get your horse set up at your trailer; light breakfast available for you  
9:00-9:45 ----- Registration: sign waivers; get your group assignment and packet; meet your mentor  
10:00-10:30----- Welcome, Introductions and Briefing  
10:30-12:30 ----- Groups begin circulating through assigned stations with your mentor  
12:30-1:30----- Lunch (provided) and Lecture/discussion  
1:30- 3:30 ----- Continue rotating through the stations with your coach  
3:30- ? ----- Conclusion: Your choice-socialize, practice obstacles, ride more trail, or depart.

**Fees:** \$40 - rider with horse; \$35 - auditor (no horse). Entry fees include a light breakfast and lunch.
